Subject: Runway 9-27/Taxiway "A" Reconstruction

Project: Phase 3 (Final Phase) Taxiway "A" Work

Greetings:

The Airport Authority is pleased to announce the re-start of the Runway 9-27/Taxiway "A" Reconstruction Project. Phase 3 of this project will represent the reconstruction of the remaining Taxiway "A" Reconstruction.

The enclosed diagram depicts the initial construction schedule for the project, which is scheduled to commence on Tuesday, May 30th, 2017, at 7:00 AM. During the Phase 3 work, Runways 9/27, 18/36 and Taxiway B will be fully operational, and the Taxiway A work will be accomplished as depicted in the diagram. As such, there will be back-taxi operations in effect on Runway 9/27.

Throughout the project, daily updates to construction activity will be available by contacting the Airport Office (462-6508), and can also be found on the [Construction Update Tab](#) of the Airport Website at www.vpz.org, or by clicking on the [Runway Construction Updates Sliding Window](#) on the Homepage. The Airport will also use its Social Media Outlets of Facebook (Porter County Regional Airport) and Twitter (@FlyVPZ) to communicate updates. Follow the Airport on either outlet to be informed of the most up-to-date information regarding the Project.

The Project Schedule requires approximately thirty (30) Calendar Days to complete the bulk of the pavement reconstruction. FAA specifications require that temporary markings be placed on the newly placed pavement for at least thirty (30) days, so some closure will again occur later in the summer, after August 8th, to place final markings on the taxiway. This plan allows for work to be suspended, similar to last year, so that the Airport can support its EAA AirVenture (Oshkosh) traffic and Collings Foundation Visit. Be advised that weather may have an effect on the Construction Schedule, and daily updates can be obtained as earlier advised in this Memorandum. Please maintain your vigilance when operating during these segments of work, and help us to ensure a safe and timely completion to this important Airport Improvement Project. Should you require any additional information, please feel free to contact the Airport Office.

Thank you in advance for understanding, that a short period of inconvenience on all of our parts will yield a safe and improved runway and taxiway environment to be used for many years to come.
